

Generations Park Amenities

#4 Travis Solomon Memorial Lacrosse Box: 220' x 85' Covered arena with lighting, blue tooth music capabilities, sports team seating, limited spectator seating.

#10 Main Soccer Field: 350' x 235' A larger field, stadium lighting, bleachers, scoreboard, fenced in, with high quality natural grass.

#3 Practice Field: 120' x 200' A smaller field, fenced in, natural grass.

#7 Pavilion: 30' x 60' Covered with picnic tables, one electrical outlet, and close to playground.

#14 Tewathahitha Walking Trail: 3,325 feet (0.60 mile) of paved trails, picnic tables, benches, dog waste containers, trash cans, bridges, and natural ponds.

#16 Walking Trail Picnic Area: Picnic tables, shade from large trees, trash cans, small exercise equipment, and wooden ship playground.

#15 Walking Trail Baseball Field: 200' x 200' Baseball diamond with backstop fencing and benches.

#9 Public Bathrooms: Separate male and female restrooms. 2 stalls on the women's side and 1 stall and 2 urinals on the men's side, sinks, trash cans, and a water fountain.

#5 Playground: Outdoor play area for children with recycled rubber mulch flooring. Available equipment: swings, climbers, bridges, and slides. Trash cans and benches.

#8 Basketball Court: 60' x 80' Paved court with two basketball hoops, lighting, and painted court lines. Basketballs available.

Margaret Terrance Memorial Way: 0.70 miles of maintained sidewalks and street lighting.

Parking: 45 spots

- #P1 Basketball Court Parking Lot: 16 spots (2 handicap spots) and electric vehicle charging station.
- #P2 Walking Trail Parking Lot: 25 spots (2 handicap spots).

Additional Parking can be requested directly from the Tribal Administration Building, the Office for the Aging, and/or the Diabetes Center.

#6 Concession Stand: 30' x 15' kitchen with refrigerator, sink, counters, commercial gas stove, microwave, and service window.

FAQ:

- Are there outlets on the walking trail?
 - \circ $\,$ No, there are no outlets or lighting on the walking trail.
- Can dogs walk on the trail?
 - Yes, they must remain on a leash. There are two dog waste receptacles with bags available along the trail.
- Can we have bounce houses at the park?
 - No, bounce houses are not allowed because they require electricity and water that causes flooding.
- Can I play my own music in the lacrosse box?
 - Yes, you can connect your device to the Bluetooth feature located on the second metal beam next to the Zamboni doors.
- Are there outlets in the Lacrosse Box?
 - Yes, there are 5 outlets available. One in the penalty box and 4 on outside beams.
- Is Generations Park open in the winter?
 - Yes, the walking trail and sidewalks are plowed and salted throughout the winter season. The Lacrosse Box is open. The restrooms are open on a limited winter schedule, M-F, 7-4.

Amphitheater Amenities

Amphitheater: State-of-the-art band stage, sound system, and grass seating for 500 (bring your own chair).

Basketball/Pickleball Courts: Two paved courts with two basketball hoops, lighting, and painted court lines. Basketballs available.

Volleyball Courts: Two sand volleyball courts with nets and volleyballs available.
