In accordance with the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe's Native American Preference Policy, the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe will give preference in the award of a Contract to approved Native American Owned Businesses/Companies, as certified by the Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe's Compliance Department. Any proponent claiming Native American Preference must give evidence to support this claim with their submitted proposal. The successful Contractor, as well as their Sub-Contractors, will be required to complete a Native American Preference Employment Plan and Agreement.

The Saint Regis Mohawk Tribe reserves the right to accept any proposal, whether it is the lowest or not, or may reject any and all proposals.
